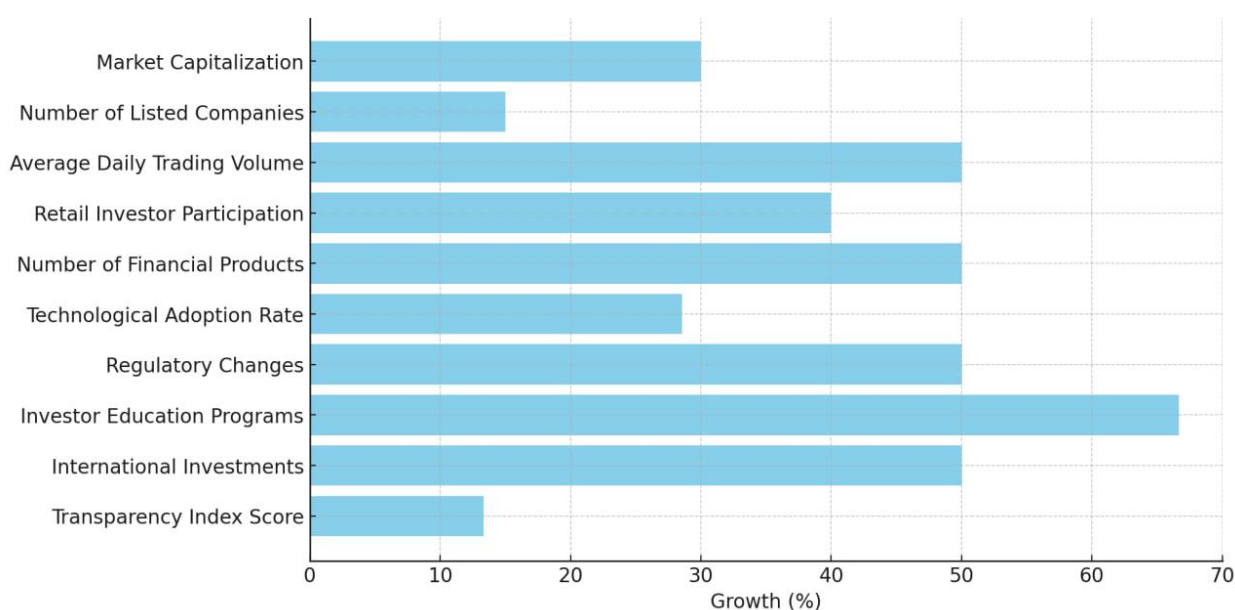


Diagram1. Growth metrics of financial market Indicators
